**Home Finale:** The Bears conclude regular-season conference action as they hit the road this weekend to face ETSU Friday and Gardner-Webb Saturday.

**The Bucs (24-26, 9-7 A-Sun):** ETSU finishes out its regular season by hosting Mercer on Friday. The Bucs rank third in the league with a .283 team batting average, led by Jessica Hackworth who is hitting .347 with nine doubles and 33 RBIs. Stephanie Gaynord is also an offensive threat for the Bucs, leading the team in slugging percentage (.593) and runs scored (44). Gaynord garnered A-Sun Player of the

Week honors on April 9 and is tied for second in the league with four triples. Marissa Hardy leads ETSU with a 2.13 ERA and a 5-1 record. The freshman received A-Sun Pitcher of the Week accolades on April 16 after pitching ETSU's first no-hitter in school history in a game against Virginia Intermont. Andrea Mangrum is in her second season as the head coach for the Bucs. Her 2006 squad finished with a 22-36 record overall and a 9-11 record in the A-Sun.

**The Bulldogs (31-21-1, 9-4-1 A-Sun):** Gardner-Webb travels to Campbell before wrapping up its regular-season play against the Bears at home. GWU tops the league in team batting average with seven players averaging over .300. Abbie Looper leads the team, hitting .370 at the plate with five doubles and five triples. The senior ranks third in the conference with 29 stolen bases. Two Bulldogs garnered A-Sun weekly honors during the month of March for their offensive play: Joanna Ward received the award on March 5 and Melody Harrell earned the honor two weeks later on March 19. Taryn Beck leads GWU in the circle with a 17-8 record and a 2.27 ERA. The junior has struck out 146 batters, good for fourth in the league, and earned Atlantic Sun Pitcher of the Week honors on April 2. Tom Cole is in his seventh season at the helm of the program with a 129-195-2 record in his first six seasons at GWU.

**Last Outing:** The Bears split in a doubleheader with A-Sun leader Kennesaw State. KSU took the first game, 7-1, and the Bears earned the 3-1 win in game two. With two runners in scoring position, freshman Jena Ellis knocked a double to left center field to drive in two runs in the fourth inning and push the Bears past the Owls.

**Freshman Power:** In the Bears' last two wins, two different freshman have come through with game-winning RBIs. Laura Persons had a walk-off RBI-single to lead Mercer to a 7-6 victory over Belmont. Jena Ellis registered a two-run double to put the Bears ahead of A-Sun leader Kennesaw State for the win.

**Conference Leaders:** Junior Jamie Madruga is ranked second overall in the league with a .385 batting average and ranks in the top 10 in nine other categories: first in slugging percentage (.750), tied for first in home runs (13), second in on-base percentage (.475) and total bases (111), tied for third in doubles (15), tied for fifth in runs scored (38), tied for sixth in walks (25), eighth in RBIs (38), and ninth in hits (57).

C.J. Martin is tied for sixth with 25 walks and Kelley Bretscher is third with 17 sacrifice hits. Freshman Jena Ellis is tenth in the league with 13 stolen bases. Stephanie Rossman holds seventh place in strikeouts with 101.

**Note:** Through games as of April 25.

**National Numbers:** Through games as of April 22, two Bears rank nationally. Jamie Madruga is 26th in the NCAA in slugging percentage (.777) and Kelley Bretscher ranks 20th in sacrifice hits per game (.33).

**Record Chasers:** Senior Kelley Bretscher is now in second place in the Mercer record books for games started and is five starts away from taking over the record. She started off the year with 173 games started and has started 52 this season. Bretscher took over second

place, surpassing Meghan Clark (2003-05) at 179 games started, earlier this season. Crystal Pardue (2001-04) holds the record with 229. C.J. Martin and Kristin Talamantes are tied for third in the same category with 200 starts. Bretscher also moved into fourth place for runs scored, now totaling 101 in her career. Third place is held by Stacy Nagel (2000-03) with 104 runs scored.

Junior Jamie Madruga holds third place in the Mercer record books for home runs. She entered the season with 14 home runs and has already belted 13 home runs this season. Meghan Clark (2003-05) holds second place with 38 home runs. Madruga also moved into fourth in the record books in career RBIs. She started the season with 49 and has already knocked in 38 runs this season. The third-place spot is held by Nikki Bowey (2000-03) with 108 RBIs. After knocking a double against Lipscomb, Madruga took over sole possession of third place for career doubles with 30. Second-place is held by Meghan Clark (2003-05) with 33 doubles.

Senior Stephanie Rossman took over second place in the record book for strikeouts after the weekend at home. Rossman has now retired 261 batters in her career and leads the team this season. First place is held by Katie Rosentreter (2003-06) with 722 strikeouts.

**Stiff Competition:** The Bears have faced two nationally ranked opponents this season, falling to No. 25 N.C. State, 1-0, at the USF adidas Invitational earlier this season, and dropping a 9-0 decision to No. 2 Alabama earlier this week.

**MIKE RAYNOR**  
**INTERIM HEAD COACH**  
**First Season ♦ Georgia Southern, 1974**

Mike Raynor begins his first season as the interim head coach for the Mercer softball program. Raynor is the fifth head coach in school history, taking over a team that returns eight starters and finished with a 26-28 overall record and a 12-6 record in Atlantic Sun Conference play last season.

"We are extremely pleased that Mike has accepted the head softball position," said Pope. "He knows our conference well since he has umpired in it for quite a few years. He is familiar with the talent level of the Mercer team and also with the teams in the Atlantic Sun Conference. Mike has enjoyed tremendous success with travel teams in the Atlanta area and I feel this will be a great advantage to him from a recruiting standpoint. We think he is a perfect fit."

Raynor has coached travel teams in Cobb County for the past 14 years, most recently serving as coach for the East Cobb Bullets Gold team. His teams won two national championships and five state championships. Last year, he also served as a community coach at Sequoyah High School, the 2006 AAAA State Champions.

Raynor has also served as a collegiate umpire for the past 15 years. Until recently, he served as the president of the Southeastern Collegiate Umpires Association, along with acting as the co-coordinator of umpires for the Atlantic Coast Conference and the coordinator of umpires for the Peach Belt Conference. He also served on umpire staffs with the Southeastern Conference, the Atlantic Sun Conference, the Southern Conference and Conference USA. In 2006, he umpired in the NCAA Division I Regional at Fresno State and has umpired in numerous NCAA conference championship tournaments. He was named the 2005 Official of the Year by the Georgia Athletic Officials Association.

In 1974, Raynor earned his bachelor's degree in education from Georgia Southern and went on to serve as the head baseball coach at Cook County High School. During his time at Cook County, he took over the responsibilities of Athletics Director and Head Football Coach.

"With the rich tradition and history at Mercer, I think we have an excellent opportunity to attract student-athletes to be strong competitors in the Atlantic Sun," said Raynor. "I am excited to be here and have the opportunity to build and expand the softball program."

A native of Fitzgerald, Ga., he and his wife, Brenda, have three daughters, Page, Molly, and Alison.
