Back Home: The Bears return home as they continue A-Sun action Friday and Saturday at Sikes Field. Mercer hosts North Florida Friday in a doubleheader at 5 p.m. On Saturday, the Bears face Jacksonville in a twin bill that has been dubbed the Series of the Week by the A-Sun. First pitch is scheduled for 3 p.m.

The Lady Ospreys (30-19, 6-6 A-Sun): Mercer and North Florida have faced one common non-conference opponent. UNF swept Florida A&M in a mid-week doubleheader this week, defeating the Lady Rattlers 16-4 and 7-6 at home. The Bears traveled to Tallahassee to face FAMU in February and split the double-

header, dropping the first game 4-3 and taking the second game 7-6. Gwen Williams is the offensive catalyst for UNF, averaging .388 at the plate with nine doubles, seven home runs and 37 RBIs. The junior picked up A-Sun Player of the Week honors on April 2 and is ranked third in the league in batting average. UNF ranks second in the conference in team pitching with a 2.10 overall ERA. Devyn Findley paces the Lady Ospreys with a 15-3 record and a 1.55 ERA. The freshman earned back-to-back A-Sun Pitcher of the Week honors in mid-March and leads the league in individual pitching. Katie Brosky is also among the top hurlers in the league, ranking eighth with a 2.35 ERA.

The Dolphins (15-37, 4-8 A-Sun): The doubleheader against Jacksonville will determine much for the conference tournament, with both teams fighting for a spot in the six-team tournament. Mercer and JU have faced one common non-conference opponent with the Dolphins sweeping Florida A&M, 11-3 and 7-1, and the Bears splitting the doubleheader, falling 4-3 and winning 7-6. Jacksonville has earned four conference wins, grabbing one game each from Campbell, Belmont, North Florida and Gardner-Webb. Juniors Patricia Melo and Jillian Mirante pace the Dolphins offensively, averaging .314 and .310 at the plate, respectively. Senior Katie Buell leads the JU pitching staff with a 3.26 ERA and a 6-7 record. As a team, the Dolphins rank seventh in the league in batting and eighth in pitching.

Last Conference Outing: The Bears picked up their first conference wins of the season, splitting in the doubleheaders against Lipscomb and Belmont in Nashville. Mercer dropped the first game of the twin bill against the Lady Bisons, 10-1, but fought back in the second game to take the 5-4 win. The Bears took the first game of the doubleheader against the Bruins, 5-4, but fell in the second game, 9-6. Jamie Madruga led the Bears during the weekend, batting .583 and scoring five runs with a double and a home run.

Hot at the Plate: Jamie Madruga had two perfect games last weekend, going 3-for-3 with a double in the loss against Lipscomb and 4-for-4 with a home run in the win against Belmont. The junior continues to hold the top spot in the conference for individual batting average with a .418 average and is also leading the league in slugging percentage and total bases. The Warner Robins, Ga., native is looking to become the first Bear to lead the A-Sun in average since Kristi Hopkins hit a league-leading .419 in 2000.

Conference Leaders: Junior Jamie Madruga leads the league with a .418 batting average and ranks in the top 10 in eight other categories: first in slugging percentage (.799) and total bases (107), second in on-base percentage (.487), tied for second in home runs (12) and doubles (15), sixth in runs scored (34), eighth in hits (56), and tied for eighth in RBIs (35).

C.J. Martin is tied for fifth with 25 walks and Kelley Bretscher is third with 17 sacrifice hits. Freshman Jena Ellis is tenth in the league with 13 stolen bases.

Stephanie Rossman moved up in the rankings after the weekend in Nashville, now holding the ninth-place spot in strikeouts with 85.

National Numbers: Through games as of April 15, two Bears rank nationally in the NCAA. Jamie Madruga holds three rankings: 21st in slugging percentage (.811), 28th in doubles per game (.33) and 40th in batting average (.424). Kelley Bretscher ranks 15th in sacrifice hits per game (.38).

Record Chasers: Senior Kelley Bretscher is now in second place in the Mercer record books for games started and is 11 starts away from taking over the record. She started off the year with 173 games started and has started in 46 this season. Bretscher took over second place, surpassing Meghan Clark (2003-05) at 179 games started, earlier this season. Crystal Pardue (2001-04) holds the record with 229. C.J. Martin and Kristin Talamantes are tied for third in the same category with 194 starts. Bretscher also moved into fourth place for runs scored, now totaling 100 in her career. Third place is held by Stacy Nagel (2000-03) with 104 runs scored.

Junior Jamie Madruga holds third place in the Mercer record books for home runs. She entered the season with 14 home runs and has already belted 12 home runs this season. Meghan Clark (2003-05) holds second place with 38 home runs. Madruga also moved into fourth in the record books in career RBIs. She started the season with 49 and has already knocked in 35 runs this season. The third-place spot is held by Nikki Bowey (2000-03) with 108 RBIs. After knocking a double against Lipscomb, Madruga took over sole possession of third place for career doubles with 30. Second-place is held by Meghan Clark (2003-05) with 33 doubles.

Senior Stephanie Rossman is climbing her way up the record books, taking over fourth in strikeouts with 240. Third place is held by Kristi Montgomery (2000-03) with 250 strikeouts.

Stiff Competition: The Bears have faced two nationally ranked opponents this season, falling to No. 25 N.C. State, 1-0, at the USF adidas Invitational earlier this season, and dropping a 9-0 decision to No. 2 Alabama earlier this week.

MIKE RAYNOR
INTERIM HEAD COACH
First Season ♦ Georgia Southern, 1974

Mike Raynor begins his first season as the interim head coach for the Mercer softball program. Raynor is the fifth head coach in school history, taking over a team that returns eight starters and finished with a 26-28 overall record and a 12-6 record in Atlantic Sun Conference play last season.

"We are extremely pleased that Mike has accepted the head softball position," said Pope. "He knows our conference well since he has umpired in it for quite a few years. He is familiar with the talent level of the Mercer team and also with the teams in the Atlantic Sun Conference. Mike has enjoyed tremendous success with travel teams in the Atlanta area and I feel this will be a great advantage to him from a recruiting standpoint. We think he is a perfect fit."

Raynor has coached travel teams in Cobb County for the past 14 years, most recently serving as coach for the East Cobb Bullets Gold team. His teams won two national championships and five state championships. Last year, he also served as a community coach at Sequoyah High School, the 2006 AAAA State Champions.

Raynor has also served as a collegiate umpire for the past 15 years. Until recently, he served as the president of the Southeastern Collegiate Umpires Association, along with acting as the co-coordinator of umpires for the Atlantic Coast Conference and the coordinator of umpires for the Peach Belt Conference. He also served on umpire staffs with the Southeastern Conference, the Atlantic Sun Conference, the Southern Conference and Conference USA. In 2006, he umpired in the NCAA Division I Regional at Fresno State and has umpired in numerous NCAA conference championship tournaments. He was named the 2005 Official of the Year by the Georgia Athletic Officials Association.
