On the Road Again: Mercer continues its nine-game road stretch with a doubleheader in Tallahassee, Fla., against the 2006 Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference champions Florida A&M.

The Lady Rattlers (0-9): Florida A&M hosts Mercer in its home opener for the 2007 season. It is also the first doubleheader for the Lady Rattlers this season. FAMU enters Wednesday's games on a nine game losing streak, dropping all its contests of the season so far. The losses include games against Washington and Florida State, who were ranked 17th and 22nd, respectively, in the latest ESPN.com/

USA Softball Collegiate Top 25 Poll. The Lady Rattlers also fell to Atlantic Sun Conference member ETSU, 7-4, in the Wilson Tournament last weekend.

Unika McIntosh leads the Lady Rattler offense with a .286 batting average. The freshman has scored two runs on two hits in seven at bats. Ashley Smith follows close behind with a .250 batting average. Melissa Oliphant leads the team with three RBIs and has the team's only home run of the season. Destiny Gordon is the team leader in the circle with a 6.16 ERA, striking out 10 batters in 19.1 innings.

Florida A&M returns 11 letterwinners from its 2006 squad that finished 40-25 overall and 14-0 in the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference. The Lady Rattlers were the MEAC champions and fell to Georgia Tech, 10-7, in the first round of the NCAA Regionals. Head coach Veronica Wiggins, a 1991 Florida A&M graduate, is in her 17th season with the Lady Rattlers and entered the season with a 460-465 record.

The Bears and Lady Rattlers met last season in Macon on Feb. 15, where FAMU swept the doubleheader, 7-2 and 5-3.

Conference Leaders: As a team, Mercer ranks second in the A-Sun in team batting average at .318. Jamie Madruga is tied for second in individual batting average with a .500 average and Ashley Anderson (.471) ranks sixth in the same category. Madruga is also second in slugging percentage (.938) and third with nine RBIs. Freshman Holly Oglesbee is tied for third in runs scored with eight.

Home Turf: Senior pitcher Stephanie Rossman returns to her hometown, Tallahassee, Fla., as the Bears take on Florida A&M. Rossman, a graduate of Florida High School, played two seasons at Okaloosa-Walton Community College in Niceville, Fla., before transferring to Mercer last season.

Stiff Competition: In the latest ESPN.com/USA Softball Collegiate Top 25 Poll, three of the Bears' opponents are ranked in the top 25 and one received votes. Alabama ranks the highest, tied at fifth. Georgia and N.C. State are ranked 18th and 24th, respectively. Iowa also received votes.

Preseason All-Atlantic Sun: After earning All-Atlantic Sun First Team honors last season, junior first baseman Jamie Madruga was selected to the 2007 All-Atlantic Sun Preseason Team. The native of Warner Robins, Ga., finished the 2006 season ranked fourth in slugging percentage (.613) and sixth in batting average (.348) in the league.

Ranking Fourth: The Mercer softball team was picked to finish fourth in the Atlantic Sun Conference in the league's preseason poll voted upon by the coaches. Stetson received six first-place votes and 95 points to earn the first-place spot with Kennesaw State close behind with 93 points. Stetson, the defending regular-season champi-

ons, is also favored to win the tournament championship, which will be played on its home field May 10-12. Campbell earned 69 points for third place and the Bears finished one point behind the Camels to take fourth place. Behind Mercer were North Florida and ETSU in fifth and sixth with Gardner-Webb, Jacksonville, Lipscomb and Belmont rounding out the poll.

Record Chasers: Senior Kelley Bretscher is now tied for second place in the Mercer career record books for games started. She started off the year with 173 games started and after a weekend at the Panther Invitational, she surpassed Katie Rosentreter's (2003-06) 177 starts and is now tied with Meghan Clark (2003-05) at 179 games started. Crystal Pardue (2001-04) holds the record with 229.

Junior Jamie Madruga is currently fifth in the Mercer record books for home runs. She entered the season with 14 home runs, just six short of the fourth place spot held by Nikki Bowey (2000-03). Madruga has already belted two homers this season, needing four more to tie for the fourth place spot and five to have sole possession of it.

MIKE RAYNOR
INTERIM HEAD COACH
First Season ♦ Georgia Southern, 1974

Mike Raynor begins his first season as the interim head coach for the Mercer softball program. Raynor is the fifth head coach in school history, taking over a team that returns eight starters and finished with a 26-28 overall record and a 12-6 record in Atlantic Sun Conference play last season.

"We are extremely pleased that Mike has accepted the head softball position," said Pope. "He knows our conference well since he has umpired in it for quite a few years. He is familiar with the talent level of the Mercer team and also with the teams in the Atlantic Sun Conference. Mike has enjoyed tremendous success with travel teams in the Atlanta area and I feel this will be a great advantage to him from a recruiting standpoint. We think he is a perfect fit."

Raynor has coached travel teams in Cobb County for the past 14 years, most recently serving as coach for the East Cobb Bullets Gold team. His teams won two national championships and five state championships. Last year, he also served as a community coach at Sequoyah High School, the 2006 AAAA State Champions.

Raynor has also served as a collegiate umpire for the past 15 years. Until recently, he served as the president of the Southeastern Collegiate Umpires Association, along with acting as the co-coordinator of umpires for the Atlantic Coast Conference and the coordinator of umpires for the Peach Belt Conference. He also served on umpire staffs with the Southeastern Conference, the Atlantic Sun Conference, the Southern Conference and Conference USA. In 2006, he umpired in the NCAA Division I Regional at Fresno State and has umpired in numerous NCAA conference championship tournaments. He was named the 2005 Official of the Year by the Georgia Athletic Officials Association.

In 1974, Raynor earned his bachelor's degree in education from Georgia Southern and went on to serve as the head baseball coach at Cook County High School. During his time at Cook County, he took over the responsibilities of Athletics Director and Head Football Coach.

"With the rich tradition and history at Mercer, I think we have an excellent opportunity to attract student-athletes to be strong competitors in the Atlantic Sun," said Raynor. "I am excited to be here and have the opportunity to build and expand the softball program."

A native of Fitzgerald, Ga., he and his wife, Brenda, have three daughters, Page, Molly, and Alison.
