**Back at it:** The Bears hit the road Thursday as they travel to Clearwater, Fla., to participate in the USF/adidas Invitational. Mercer is set to take on N.C. State, Chattanooga, Michigan State, Villanova and Long Island during the four-day tournament.

**The Wolfpack (14-6):** N.C. State finished first in the Atlantic Coast Conference last season with a 50-21 overall record and a 14-6 league record. Ace Abbie Sims is a powerful force for the Wolfpack, recording 106 strikeouts in her 12 appearances with a 8-3 record and 1.95 ERA. N.C. State defeated A-Sun

member Gardner-Webb early in the season with a 5-0 decision in the Carolina Classic in Chapel Hill, N.C. Lisa Navas is in her fourth season at the helm of the program, leading the Wolfpack to a 123-73 record in her first three seasons.

**The Lady Mocs (11-12):** Freshman Tia Blosser leads Chattanooga with a .328 batting average. Brooke Loudermilk leads UTC in the circle with a 7-4 record and a 2.70 ERA. The Lady Mocs took on Atlantic Sun member Lipscomb in Chattanooga and split with the Lady Bisons, falling 2-8 and winning 4-2. The Lady Mocs return eight position starters from their 2006 squad that finished fourth in the Southern Conference with a 38-35 overall record and a 11-10 league record. Frank Reed is in his sixth year with the Lady Mocs and has led them to a 210-126 record in his first five seasons.

**The Spartans (7-6):** Michigan State is led offensively by Kara Weigle, a sophomore with a .451 batting average with five triples and 15 RBIs on the season. Megan Hair mans the circle for the Spartans with a 2.91 ERA and a 3-3 record. Michigan State returns 16 letterwinners from its 2006 team that went 34-25 overall and 9-11 in the Big 10. Head coach Jacquie Joseph is in her 14th season with the Spartans, leading them to a 412-346-1 record in her 13 complete seasons.

**The Wildcats (7-3):** Villanova and Mercer have both faced Alabama State this season. The Bears fell in the season-opening doubleheader, 7-1 and 5-4, while the Wildcats defeated ASU, 10-0, in their season opener at the UCF Tournament. Senior catcher Cassie Koenig is the offensive threat for Villanova, sporting a .548 batting average with 17 hits in 31 at-bats. The team returns 15 letterwinners from its 2006 squad that finished 13-40 overall and 2-20 in the Big East Conference. Maria DiBernardi is in her 24th season with the Wildcats and has led them to a 579-431-7 record in her 23 complete seasons.

**The Blackbirds (3-7):** Long Island defeated No. 31 Cal-State Fullerton, 5-4, as part of the Palm Springs Invitational in California. The other two wins for the Blackbirds came over former Atlantic Sun member Florida Atlantic. Randi Gillespie leads Long Island offensively with a .483 batting average. Jenny Giles leads the Blackbirds in the circle with a 2-3 record and a 2.89 ERA. The Blackbirds return seven letterwinners for their 2006 squad that finished with a 34-23 overall record and a 17-3 record in the Northeast Conference. Roy Kortmann is in his 13th year at the helm of the program, leading the Blackbirds to a 333-261-2 record in his first 12 seasons.

**Conference Leaders:** As a team, Mercer is second in the A-Sun in team batting average at .314. Junior Jamie Madruga leads the league with a .500 batting average and Ashley Anderson (.409) ranks fourth in the same category. Madruga is also ranked in the top 10 in eight other categories: first in slugging percentage (.940), second in on-base percentage (.544), tied for second in home runs (5), tied for third in RBIs (22), fourth in doubles (7), fifth in runs scored (17), sixth in total bases (47), and tied for eighth in hits (25). Holly Oglesbee is tied for third with 18 runs scored and C.J. Martin leads the conference with a .563 on-base percentage. Anderson and Kelley Bretscher are ranked third and fifth, respectively, in on-base percentage. Ace April Cunningham ranks seventh with 34 strikeouts.

**Note:** Through games as of March 7.

**Record Chasers:** Senior Kelley Bretscher is now in second place in the Mercer career record books for games started and is 42 starts away from taking over the record. She started off the year with 173 games started and has started in 15 games this season. Bretscher took over second place, surpassing Meghan Clark (2003-05) at 179 games started, earlier this season. Crystal Pardue (2001-04) holds the record with 229.

Junior Jamie Madruga is currently fifth in the Mercer record books for home runs. She entered the season with 14 home runs, just six short of the fourth place spot held by Nikki Bowey (2000-03). Madruga has already belted five homers this season, needing just one more to tie for the fourth-place spot and two to have sole possession of it.

**Stiff Competition:** In the latest ESPN.com/USA Softball Collegiate Top 25 Poll, two of the Bears' opponents are ranked in the top 25 and one received votes. Alabama ranks the highest at third. Georgia holds 23rd place and N.C. State received votes.

**Preseason All-Atlantic Sun:** After earning All-Atlantic Sun First Team honors last season, junior first baseman Jamie Madruga was selected to the 2007 All-Atlantic Sun Preseason Team. The native of Warner Robins, Ga., finished the 2006 season ranked fourth in slugging percentage (.613) and sixth in batting average (.348) in the league.

**Up Next:** After returning home from Florida, the Bears have four days off before flying to Sacramento, Calif., to take part in the Capital Classic that will be held Mar. 16-17. Mercer is set to take on Colorado State, Iowa, Santa Clara, Iowa State and Brigham Young during the two-day tournament. On Monday, Mar. 19, the Bears compete in a doubleheader at San Jose State to end their 14-game road game set.

**MIKE RAYNOR**  
**INTERIM HEAD COACH**  
**First Season ♦ Georgia Southern, 1974**

Mike Raynor begins his first season as the interim head coach for the Mercer softball program. Raynor is the fifth head coach in school history, taking over a team that returns eight starters and finished with a 26-28 overall record and a 12-6 record in Atlantic Sun Conference play last season.

"We are extremely pleased that Mike has accepted the head softball position," said Pope. "He knows our conference well since he has umpired in it for quite a few years. He is familiar with the talent level of the Mercer team and also with the teams in the Atlantic Sun Conference. Mike has enjoyed tremendous success with travel teams in the Atlanta area and I feel this will be a great advantage to him from a recruiting standpoint. We think he is a perfect fit."

Raynor has coached travel teams in Cobb County for the past 14 years, most recently serving as coach for the East Cobb Bullets Gold team. His teams won two national championships and five state championships. Last year, he also served as a community coach at Sequoyah High School, the 2006 AAAA State Champions.

Raynor has also served as a collegiate umpire for the past 15 years. Until recently, he served as the president of the Southeastern Collegiate Umpires Association, along with acting as the co-coordinator of umpires for the Atlantic Coast Conference and the coordinator of umpires for the Peach Belt Conference. He also served on umpire staffs with the Southeastern Conference, the Atlantic Sun Conference, the Southern Conference and Conference USA. In 2006, he umpired in the NCAA Division I Regional at Fresno State and has umpired in numerous NCAA conference championship tournaments. He was named the 2005 Official of the Year by the Georgia Athletic Officials Association.

In 1974, Raynor earned his bachelor's degree in education from Georgia Southern and went on to serve as the head baseball coach at Cook County High School. During his time at Cook County, he took over the responsibilities of Athletics Director and Head Football Coach.

"With the rich tradition and history at Mercer, I think we have an excellent opportunity to attract student-athletes to be strong competitors in the Atlantic Sun," said Raynor. "I am excited to be here and have the opportunity to build and expand the softball program."

A native of Fitzgerald, Ga., he and his wife, Brenda, have three daughters, Page, Molly, and Alison.
