

SPECIAL REQUEST TO PARTICIPATE IN COMMENCEMENT CEREMONIES

(Undergraduate Students)

Only those students who are in a position to complete all requirements for graduation by the end of spring semester may participate in the commencement ceremony for that academic year. Students to whom degrees have already been awarded during the current academic year (i.e., at the end of the previous summer or fall semester) may also participate in that year's commencement ceremony.

*In extraordinary situations, a student, who requires no more than **12 credit hours** for graduation and plans to complete the degree requirements during the summer session immediately following commencement, may petition the Office of the Registrar for special consideration to participate in the commencement ceremony.*
