Position Opening - Ministerial Intern to Young Professionals

Job Description—Young Professionals Intern for Providence Baptist Church

Job Summary:

The Young Professionals Intern shall be responsible for the development and implementation of a ministry focused toward young professionals, ages 22-30. This shall include: Bible Study, Discipleship, Mission Opportunities, Outreach, and Community-building.

Essential Functions:

The intern will be expected to develop personal relationships with current church members in this age group, as well as with prospects in this age group. Consequently, much of the work week will happen outside of the office and during week-night and weekend hours.

In the areas of Bible Study, Discipleship, Missions, Outreach, and Community-building, the intern will be expected to assess the faith development needs of our young professionals and design opportunities for those needs to be met. This will include both on-going events, such as the development of a weekly Bible Study group and short-term events, such as one-time mission projects.

For support and guidance, the intern will meet at least quarterly with the Intern Advisory Committee and at least monthly with her/his supervisor. Both the committee and the supervisor will act as a resource for the intern.

The intern will meet weekly with the ministry team for purposes of prayer, calendaring, collaboration and sharing of ideas, observation of the "church ministerial staff process," and community.

The intern may be asked to participate in worship leadership occasionally and in the teaching of young adults on Wednesday nights. This person will be seen as a part of the ministerial staff and expected to participate in the life of the church, including Sunday mornings and Wednesday nights.

As this new ministry develops, there may be changes and additions to responsibilities assigned.
