Up Next: The Bears return to Sikes Field to start a nine-game home stretch as they host the Mercer Classic. Mercer faces Austin Peay, George Washington and Oakland in the three-day tournament that will be held Feb. 23-25.

The Lady Gavs (2-0): Austin Peay opened its season against NCAA DII Kentucky Wesleyan, sweeping the series 6-3 and 10-1. Natasha Anderson led the Lady Gavs in the doubleheader, recording three hits in five at-bats for a .600 average. The Lady Gavs return 11 letterwinners from their 2006 squad that went 21-

31 overall and 10-16 in the Ohio Valley Conference. Jim Perrin, a 1970 graduate of APSU, is in his fourth year at the helm of the program, with a 38-68 record in three seasons.

The Colonials (0-0): George Washington hits the field for the first time this season at the Mercer Classic. The Colonials recorded a 24-28 record last season and finished 3-15 in the Atlantic 10 Conference. GWU returns 17 letterwinners from its 2006 team, including all nine starters. Senior shortstop Elana Meyers led the Colonials, batting .414. Katie Miller returns for George Washington as the ace of their staff after posting a 2.44 ERA and striking out 54 batters in 20 appearances. Kim Staehle, a 1993 graduate of Connecticut, is in her first season at the head of the program.

The Grizzlies (0-0): Oakland opens its season at the Mercer Classic. The Grizzlies return 14 letterwinners from their 2006 team that finished 28-31 overall and 12-12 in the Mid-Continent Conference. Sophomore Julie Owen is the top offensive returnee for the Grizzlies, posting a .282 batting average last season. Head coach Glenn MacDonald is in his second season at Oakland.

Conference Leaders: As a team, Mercer ranks second in the A-Sun in team batting average at .292. Jamie Madruga is fifth in individual batting average with a .417 average and Ashley Anderson (.400) ranks ninth in the same category. Madruga is also third in slugging percentage (.750) and tied for third with nine RBIs. C.J. Martin leads the conference in walks with nine and is tied for first in on base percentage (.586).

Fresh Power: Freshmen Stacey Condra and Jena Ellis led the Bears offensively in the doubleheader against Florida A&M. Each went 2-for-3 at the plate, including a bases-clearing triple by Ellis in the second game.

Stiff Competition: In the latest ESPN.com/USA Softball Collegiate Top 25 Poll, three of the Bears' opponents are ranked in the top 25 and one of those in the top ten. Alabama ranks the highest at fifth. Georgia and N.C. State are ranked 18th and 22nd, respectively.

Preseason All-Atlantic Sun: After earning All-Atlantic Sun First Team honors last season, junior first baseman Jamie Madruga was selected to the 2007 All-Atlantic Sun Preseason Team. The native of Warner Robins, Ga., finished the 2006 season ranked fourth in slugging percentage (.613) and sixth in batting average (.348) in the league.

Ranking Fourth: The Mercer softball team was picked to finish fourth in the Atlantic Sun Conference in the league's preseason poll voted upon by the coaches. Stetson received six first-place votes and 95 points to earn the first-place spot with Kennesaw State close behind with 93 points. Stetson, the defending regular-season champions, is also favored to win the tourna-

ment championship, which will be played on its home field May 10-12. Campbell earned 69 points for third place and the Bears finished one point behind the Camels to take fourth place. Behind Mercer were North Florida and ETSU in fifth and sixth with Gardner-Webb, Jacksonville, Lipscomb and Belmont rounding out the poll.

Record Chasers: Senior Kelley Bretscher is now in second place in the Mercer career record books for games started. She started off the year with 173 games started and has started in eight games this season, taking over second place in the record books and surpassing Meghan Clark (2003-05) at 179 games started. Crystal Pardue (2001-04) holds the record with 229.

Junior Jamie Madruga is currently fifth in the Mercer record books for home runs. She entered the season with 14 home runs, just six short of the fourth place spot held by Nikki Bowey (2000-03). Madruga has already belted two homers this season, needing four more to tie for the fourth place spot and five to have sole possession of it.

MIKE RAYNOR
INTERIM HEAD COACH
First Season ♦ Georgia Southern, 1974

Mike Raynor begins his first season as the interim head coach for the Mercer softball program. Raynor is the fifth head coach in school history, taking over a team that returns eight starters and finished with a 26-28 overall record and a 12-6 record in Atlantic Sun Conference play last season.

"We are extremely pleased that Mike has accepted the head softball position," said Pope. "He knows our conference well since he has umpired in it for quite a few years. He is familiar with the talent level of the Mercer team and also with the teams in the Atlantic Sun Conference. Mike has enjoyed tremendous success with travel teams in the Atlanta area and I feel this will be a great advantage to him from a recruiting standpoint. We think he is a perfect fit."

Raynor has coached travel teams in Cobb County for the past 14 years, most recently serving as coach for the East Cobb Bullets Gold team. His teams won two national championships and five state championships. Last year, he also served as a community coach at Sequoyah High School, the 2006 AAAA State Champions.

Raynor has also served as a collegiate umpire for the past 15 years. Until recently, he served as the president of the Southeastern Collegiate Umpires Association, along with acting as the co-coordinator of umpires for the Atlantic Coast Conference and the coordinator of umpires for the Peach Belt Conference. He also served on umpire staffs with the Southeastern Conference, the Atlantic Sun Conference, the Southern Conference and Conference USA. In 2006, he umpired in the NCAA Division I Regional at Fresno State and has umpired in numerous NCAA conference championship tournaments. He was named the 2005 Official of the Year by the Georgia Athletic Officials Association.

In 1974, Raynor earned his bachelor's degree in education from Georgia Southern and went on to serve as the head baseball coach at Cook County High School. During his time at Cook County, he took over the responsibilities of Athletics Director and Head Football Coach.
